

The Yoga of the Sun




‘When we focus our attention on the sun, the center of our universe, we draw closer to our own centre, our higher self, the sun within; we melt into it and begin to resemble it more and more.


The world needs more and more human beings capable of dedicating themselves to this work with the sun, for only love and light are capable of transforming humanity.’

Man's Subtle Bodies and Centres The Aura, the Solar Plexus, the Chakras...





come into contact with this world of light.


These centers are the aura, the solar plexus, the hara center, the chakras...'

True Alchemy or the Quest for Perfection






The Importance of Light




Vibration, Emanation, Radiation
